

Laifual Robo Gala Rulebook

Sponsor and Organizer: Zhejiang Laifual Drive Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "Sponsor" or "Laifual Drive"), with its principal place of business at Ganlin Industrial Zone, Shengzhou, Zhejiang, China.

1. Overview

The Laifual Robo Gala (the "Contest") is a global user-generated content (UGC) competition sponsored by Laifual Drive to promote innovation in robotics. Participants are invited to receive free, half-price, or loaned samples of harmonic reducers and robotic joint modules (rotary actuators) in exchange for providing feedback through original UGC, such as text reports and videos. The Contest targets robotics industry professionals, universities, and research institutions. By entering, participants agree to these Official Rules (the "Rules").

2. Eligibility

- Participants must be at least 18 years of age or the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence, whichever is higher.
- Eligible participants include individuals affiliated with robotics industry practitioners, accredited universities, or recognized research institutions.
- Employees, officers, directors, and immediate family members of the Sponsor, its affiliates, agents, and any entities involved in the Contest are ineligible.
- Participation is void where prohibited by law. The Sponsor reserves the right to verify eligibility and disqualify any participant at its sole discretion.

3. Entry Period

The Contest entry period begins on February 1, 2026. All entries must be submitted via the official landing page at <https://www.laifualdrive.com/laifual-robo-gala-drive-the-future/>.

4. How to Enter

- Participants must complete the online registration form, providing: full name, email address, affiliation (e.g., university or institution), a project proposal (200-500 words) describing intended use of the products, and consent to these Rules.
- Optional: Submit a short video pitch (1-2 minutes).
- No purchase is necessary to enter. Multiple entries per person are not permitted.
- Entries must be original and not violate any third-party rights.

5. Product Distribution

- Selected participants will receive products based on merit (e.g., innovation potential and relevance): free samples for top entries, half-price purchases for qualified applicants, or loaned samples for short-term testing.
- Selection is at the Sponsor's sole discretion, based on a review panel.
- Products are provided "as is" without warranty, express or implied. Participants assume all risks associated with product use.
- Shipping is limited to eligible regions; participants are responsible for any customs duties or

taxes.

6. UGC Submission Requirements

- Participants must submit UGC feedback with post-receipt, via the designated portal.
- UGC includes: text reports (e.g., performance analysis, benchmarks) and videos (e.g., demonstrations, results).
- All UGC must be original, created by the participant, and relevant to the products.
- UGC must not contain offensive, defamatory, or infringing content. The Sponsor reserves the right to reject or remove any UGC.
- By submitting, participants grant the Sponsor a perpetual, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, modify, and distribute the UGC (see Original Works Usage Instructions for details).

7. Judging and Prizes

- UGC will be judged on criteria including: innovation, quality of feedback, technical depth, and virality potential.
- Winners will be notified via email within 30 days of the submission deadline.
- Prizes are non-transferable and non-substitutable. Taxes on prizes are the winner's responsibility.
- Odds of winning depend on the number and quality of entries.

8. General Conditions

- The Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, modify, or suspend the Contest due to unforeseen circumstances, including technical issues or fraud.
- Participants agree to indemnify the Sponsor against any claims arising from their participation or UGC.
- These Rules are governed by the laws of the People's Republic of China (PRC), without regard to conflict of laws principles.
- Any disputes will be resolved through binding arbitration in the People's Republic of China (PRC).
- By entering, participants release the Sponsor from any liability related to the Contest.
